



2010 BaySail Science Educator and Deckhand Internships

About BaySail:

BaySail is a private, nonprofit organization based in Bay City, Michigan. We offer unforgettable environmental education and freshwater ecology programs for students aboard the schooners *Appledore IV* and *Appledore V*. Our programs include half day experiences for K-12 school groups and week-long voyages for high school students. Much of our programming takes place on the Saginaw Bay, but some programs are delivered in other port cities throughout the Great Lakes.

Internships:

Internship positions are available during the 2010 season. The primary duties will involve teaching a shipboard science program to K-12 students on day trips, locally and in other ports 1-2 hours away. Some internships will require living aboard the schooners. In addition to shipboard duties, all interns will assist with ship logistics and voyage coordination.

Positions Available:

Education Intern – *Appledore IV* (2 available)

- Two sessions:
 - April 26 – May 21, 2010 (four weeks)
 - May 17 – June 11, 2010 (four weeks)
- Stipend: \$200.00
- Based in Bay City, Michigan
- Approximately 25 hours per week
- Primary responsibilities include:
 - Teaching BaySail's environmental science program for K-12 students on half day trips aboard the schooner *Appledore IV* departing from downtown Bay City, Michigan.
 - Assisting the Program Director with trip logistics and voyage coordination.
 - Assisting the Program Director with program evaluation retrieval and assessment.

Education Intern – *Appledore V* (1 available)

- Session: May 3 – June 4, 2010 (five weeks)
- Stipend: \$250.00
- Live aboard position
- Primary responsibilities include:
 - Teaching BaySail's environmental science program for K-12 students on half day trips aboard the schooner *Appledore V*.
 - **Living aboard the schooner *Appledore V* as it sails to and delivers educational programs in neighboring Lake Huron ports.**
 - Assisting the crew with sailing duties.
 - Assisting the Program Director with trip logistics and voyage coordination.
 - Assisting the Program Director with program evaluation retrieval and assessment.

Deckhand/Education Intern – *Appledore IV* (1 available)

- Session: August 5 – September 4, 2010 (four weeks)
- Stipend: \$215.00
- Live aboard position
- Primary responsibilities include:
 - Working as a deckhand aboard the schooner *Appledore IV*.
 - Delivering educational programs while in port.
 - Assist Captain and First Mate during overnight voyaging programs.
 - **Living aboard the schooner *Appledore IV* as it sails between ports for Great Lakes United Tall Ships events.**
 - Green Bay, WI
 - Port Washington, WI
 - Chicago, IL
 - Mackinaw City, MI

All interns must:

- Be willing to work outdoors in all weather conditions.
- Be positive and enthusiastic.
- Be self-motivated and able to organize several other program volunteers.
- Enjoy working with children.
- Possess a good working knowledge of environmental science topics and be willing to learn new information as it relates to BaySail's programming.
- Be willing to perform basic sailing duties aboard the *Appledore* when needed.
- Be in good physical condition and be able to swim.
- Have reliable transportation.
